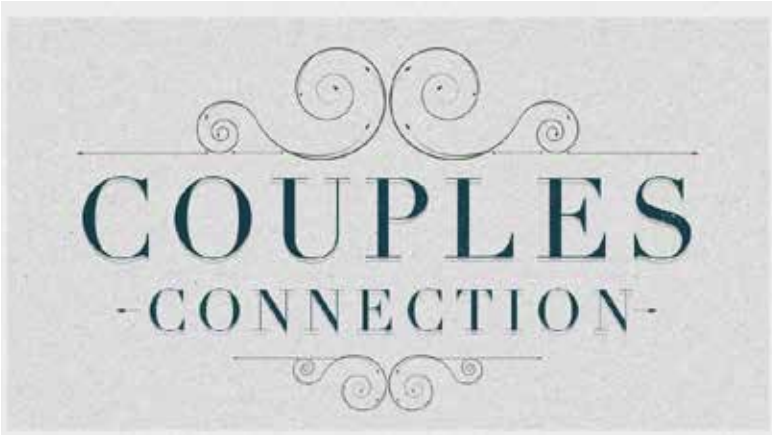
WELCOME TO FIRST BIBLE!

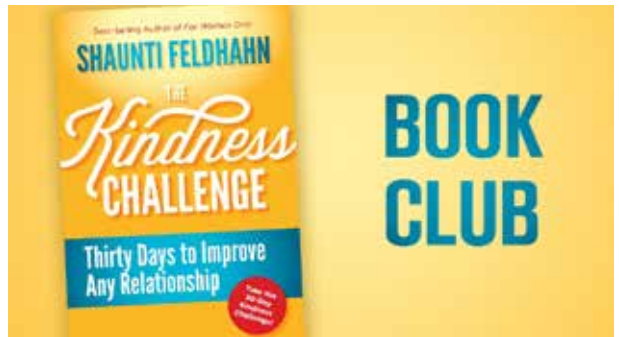


Kindness Challenge

3. Every day, do one small act of kindness for them.

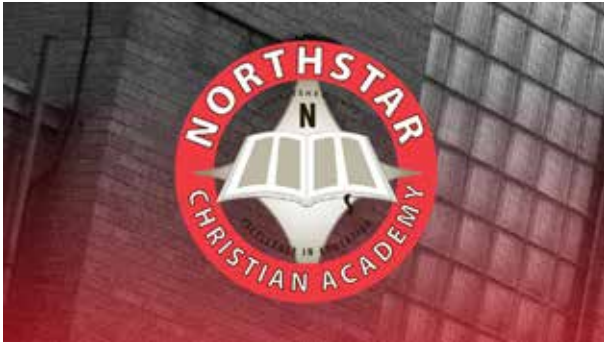
