Ireland



For 27 years FBBC has partnered with Craig and Nita Ledbetter as they serve the people of Ireland. In June, Bible Baptist Church (located in the southern Irish city of Cork) will be celebrating its 25th Anniversary. Craig, who planted the church in 1994, continues to pastor it today. When he is not teaching on Sundays, Craig spends his time discipling believers and spreading the Gospel message to the community abroad.

One of the most significant opportunities for evangelism is on St. Patrick's Day. Last year there were an estimated 30,000 people in attendance at the Cork St. Patrick's Day parade. The Ledbetters are aware of this incredible opportunity, and they have rallied their church to the cause. Besides operating the "Daniel and the Lion's Den" float, the church members will be passing out Gospel tracts and going door to door sharing the Gospel message.
