April 19, 7:00 P.M.

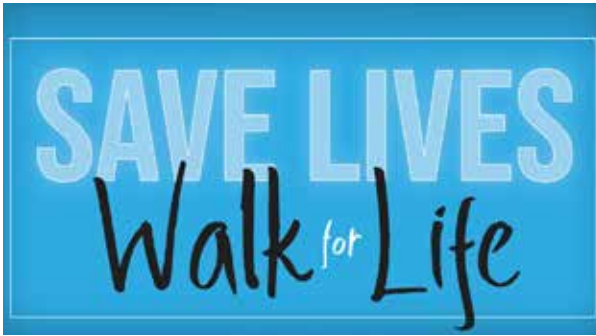

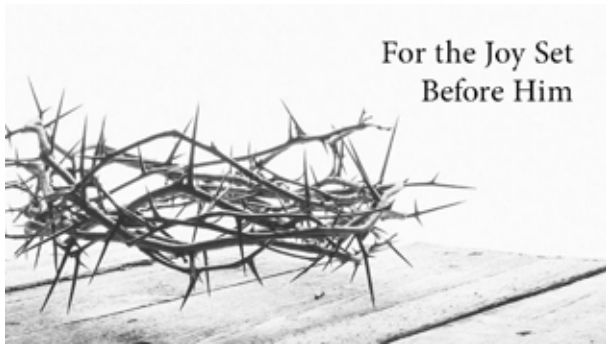
