




Verona Missions Trip



May Kindness Challenge





Season Begins Tuesday, May 14



Persecuted Church

Around the world there is growing hostility to the followers of Jesus Christ. Every day church members face restrictions, arrests, and torture for their commitment to Christ. Mr. John (a pseudonym for a supported missionary) faces many of these same problems. Despite this persecution, Mr. John remains faithful and active in his community.

A while back, Mr. John had to stop the church's regular worship services due to persecution from government officials. The government did not want men and women worshipping the God of the Bible. Now church members meet at seven satellite locations, and they continue to see their congregation multiply. The Christian school is also growing. It has eighteen full-time staff with over seventy students. Mr. John is also involved with a local Bible college. This institution is thriving with twenty-six on-campus students. These growing Christians desire to be the next generation of pastors and teachers.

In the face of great persecution, Mr. John remains dedicated to the cause of Christ. Please take a moment today to pray for Mr. John, his family, and the rest of the persecuted church.
