
The Patience of Job



We all love summer sun, picnics, and time with family and friends. Pick up a printed card from one of the Welcome Centers for more information on these special nights.






Please take time today to pray for these missionaries as they reach the people of Central America and the Caribbean with the Gospel of Jesus Christ.
