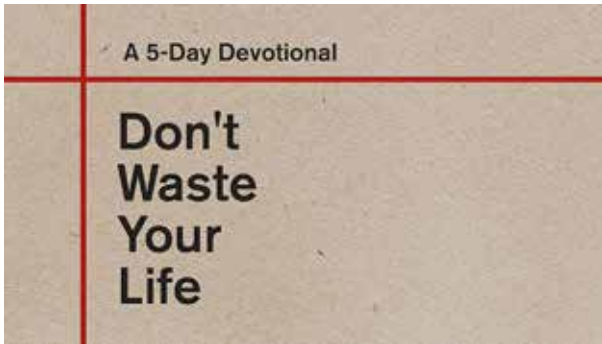
Even when our plans change, God is still able to complete His mission!
