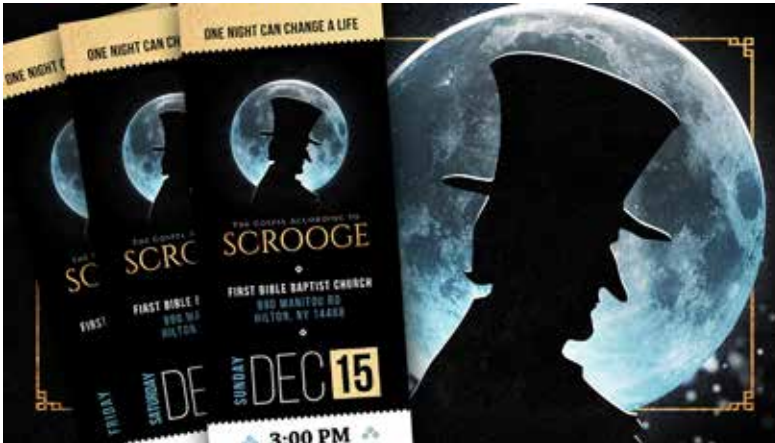


Veteran's Day

Thanksgiving Day

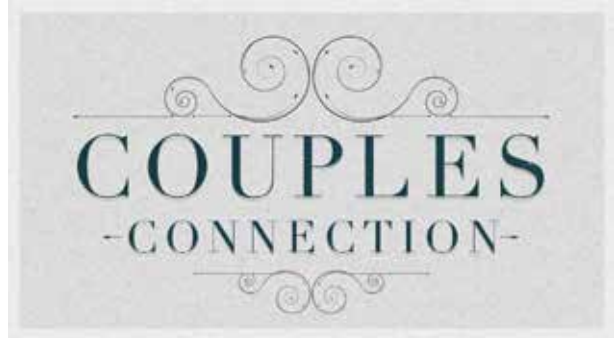

World Tour

We are Shaun, Jeri, Selena, and Micaiah Vance, missionaries to Kenya.

I (Shaun) had attended church once in a while growing up and had heard the Gospel many times, but because of different hurts I experienced, I had always rejected God's forgiveness. When I was nineteen years old, I surrendered my life to Jesus Christ and discovered He was the peace that I had been longing for. Jeri visited Decatur Baptist Church for the first time in 1997 to see her brother get baptized. It was the first time she heard a clear presentation of the Gospel. She was saved at the age of 16 and soon became involved in ministry.

We have been Decatur Baptist Church's sent missionaries to Eldoret, Kenya since 2017. For the past 2 years, our focus has been on learning the language of Swahili and building relationships with national pastors. We desire to see people come to salvation and mature in their walk with the Lord. This is primarily accomplished through Bible institutes set up in different parts of Kenya and Uganda. We desire to see local churches thrive and nationals reaching their people with the Gospel.
