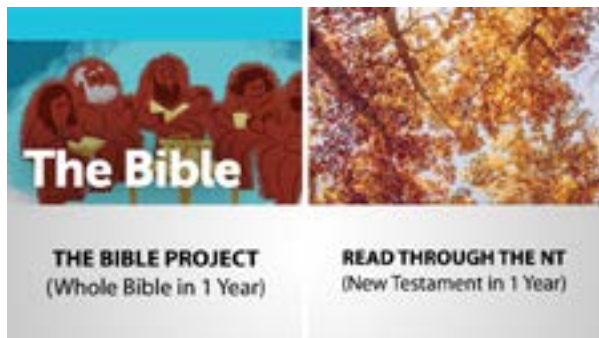

Billy & Cindy Haas

Native Americans Bemidji, Minnesota



January 2020

Tropical Cambodian Rain to Sub-Zero Minnesotan Winters –

Once members of FBBC, the Haas family became missionaries to Cambodia in 2000. Their goal was to establish Cambodian churches pastored by Cambodian Christians. After 10 years, national pastors began leading the church Billy and Cindy had planted. In 2010, the Haas family moved from tropical Cambodia to frigid Bemidji, Minnesota. Despite the dramatic change of climate, their goal has remained the same. They desire to establish Native American churches pastored by Native American Christians.

For the last 10 years, Billy and Cindy Haas have brought the hope of the Gospel to the people of Bemidji. Billy directs the Mokahum Ministry Center, a training center for Native American Christians. Billy also pastors a prospering church plant in Bemidji. Located in northern Minnesota, Bemidji is the hub of three Objiwe reservations: Red Lake, Leech Lake, and White Earth. Despite having a stroke in 2018, Billy continues to serve the Native American people. In the last few months alone, seven individuals have made decisions to follow Christ! Billy and Cindy love sharing the hope of Jesus Christ with the people of Bemidji.
